Purpose/Description

Beginning in the Fall of 2008, the Crime Victims Advocacy Council (CVAC), an independent and non-profit organization, will be offering scholarships to a degree-seeking student who is a co-victims' survivor of murder and/or vehicular homicide. These one-year scholarships are offered in the amount of \$2,000.00 and will be based upon merit, need, and the availability of funds. Criteria

For consideration of this award, applicants must: (1) Complete an application; (2) Attach a one-page essay explaining how you meet the Scholarship Fund's criteria and why you are pursuing the higher education degree; (3) Scholarship should be to an accredited technical school or college; (4) Attach a copy of current school transcripts; (5) Provide proof of homicide, such as a death certificate or police report, containing the name of, and connection to, your loved one; (6) Applicant must be a "B" student and have a good attendance record; (7) Attach a letter of recommendation from two teachers; and (8) Be willing to undergo an interview by the CVAC Scholarship Committee.
