

HOW TO BE SAFE WHEN WORKING IN A CONVENIENCE STORE

To stay safe while working in a convenience store:

- Prioritize being alert;

- Get a good look at the robber, but don't stare
- Do not chase or follow the robber
- Cooperate for the safety of themselves and others
- Tell the robber about any movements they plan to make
- Activate an alarm if it can be done safely

After the robbery

- Employees should call the police immediately and provide a description of the robber.
- They should also take notes of anything they remember about the robber, including any physical features or anything they might have touched.
- Other ways to prevent robberies include: improving lighting, installing security cameras, implementing access control systems, and using technology such as panic buttons and video surveillance.
